I. Call to Order

This meeting was called to order by Mayor Heyward at 6:30 PM.

II. Roll Call

In attendance were Councilmembers Dunmyer, III, Sausser, Salters, Scott, Smalls, Sr., Townsend, Engineer Seabrook, Planner/Zoning Administrator Holton, Attorney Austen and Mayor's Assistant Carpenter. Clerk-Treasurer Gantt was absent.

III. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

Invocation was given by Councilmember Salters, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

IV. Adoption of Agenda

Councilmember Smalls, Sr. made a motion to adopt the agenda, Councilmember Dunmyer, III seconded the motion and all voted in favor.

VI. Hot Topic Q&A:

Toy Glennon, Charleston County Assessor

Mrs. Glennon provided information on how Charleston County appraises and assesses taxes on real estate. In the presentation *she* reviewed different zoning classifications, their respective tax rates and how to appeal an assessment.
