Minutes of the meeting held in Council Chambers at 6322 HWY 162 on Thursday, March 11, 2010. Meeting was called to order by Commissioner Salters at 6:30pm.

In attendance were Commissioners Black, Prioleau, Smalls, Wolf, Planner/Zoning Administrator Holton and Clerk-Treasurer Gantt-Brown. Commissioners Heyward and Stewart were absent.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Salters; followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comments:

Approval of Minutes:

Minutes of the meeting held on February 11, 2010 were unanimously accepted with amendment. Commissioner Black stated under new business it indicates the motion was seconded by Commissioner Wolf; who was absent. He stated he seconded that motion. Motion to accept the amended minutes was made by Black; Commissioner Smalls seconded it and all voted in favor.

New Business

Request for approval of lighting plan at 5348 Hunt Course Lane; TMS# 163-00-00-013 was made by Cecelia Fewox. Paul from Coast Carolina Electric, is contracted by Mrs. Fewox, indicates the lighting won't affect any plants and vegetation which wouldn't grow for awhile. Commissioner Wolf asked if neighbors were informed and will they use timers on the lights. Mrs. Fewox states she has spoken with the neighbors, she also owns property connected to this parcel and her intention is to utilize timers for energy efficiency; she would like to have the lights go off at 9pm. Commissioner Prioleau suggests the plan be modified to include lights to illuminate outside for greatest visibility when leaving the facility. Paul stated all lights are 27ft. off the ground shining inward and downward toward the arena. Commissioner Salters asked why vegetation was on 3 of the 4 poles. Mrs. Fewox indicated the other property is her own. Motion for approval of the lighting plan with proper vegetation buffer was made by Commissioner Wolf and seconded by Commissioner Black; all voted in favor.

Mr. Holton announced the dedication for Wide Awake Park is scheduled for Saturday, March 27, 2010. Commissioner Wolf stated a clean sweep of Hwy 162 is scheduled for April 10th with help from the College of Charleston.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:45 pm.
