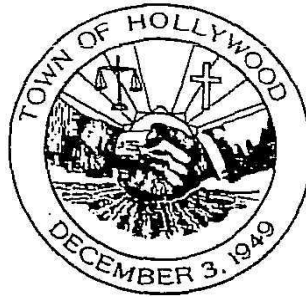

Minutes of the Special Council meeting for the Town of Hollywood held in Council Chambers at 6322 HWY 162 on Monday, May 10, 2010 at 6:30pm. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Heyward at 6:30pm.

Old Business:

FY 2010-2011 proposed budget review. Councilmember Dunmyer III asked what was budgeted for last year and where we are with regard to actual figures. Clerk-Treasurer Gantt-Brown walked to her office to print and make copies of a spreadsheet for council to review. Mayor Heyward suggest council review each line item at their leisure and get back to Mrs. Gantt-Brown with recommendations. Councilmember Sausser stated the Mayor's Assistant needs a pay raise because she has seen her all around the town doing lots of different things. Councilmember Dunmyer III asked if there is a cost of living adjustment included for staff. Mayor Heyward answered yes it is included. She stated there is only one capital project budgeted for next year; completion of Manor Park facility. Sea Island Habitat has put their volunteers on other project due to low return of Hollywood volunteers. Councilmember Sausser said that every time she comes to Town Hall the Mayor is in a meeting or away at a conference on the weekends. She feels the Mayor needs a raise for all of her hard work.

Mayor Heyward reminded everyone of the Seafood Festival on Wide Awake Park scheduled for Friday, May 14, 2010.
